Military History	<ul> <li>June 6, 1944 – D-Day, the largest amphibious landing in history, began in the early-morning hours as Allied forces landed in Normandy on the northern coast of France. Operation Overlord took months of planning and involved 1,527,000 soldiers in 47 Allied divisions along with 4,400 ships and landing craft, and 11,000 aircraft.</li> <li>June 14, 1775 - The first U.S. Military service, the Continental Army consisting of six companies of riflemen, was established by the Second Continental Congress.</li> <li>June 25, 1950 - The Korean War began as North Korean troops, led by Russianbuilt tanks, crossed the 38th parallel and launched a full scale invasion of South Korea</li> </ul>
